City of Armstrong OPEN AIR BURNING REGULATIONS

There is no open air burning allowed in the City of Armstrong,

except :

- a) A Special Burning Permit may be issued at any time, to farmers or orchardists on parcels of land having farm assessment under the B.C. Assessment Authority, and in keeping with the provisions of Bylaw No. 1390, 2000.
- b) Confined fires used for cooking food on grills and barbeques. Grills and barbeques include hibachis, chiminias, and permanently constructed fire pits with walls of non combustible material that will completely contain the fire. Cooking surfaces should consist of grilles with small enough openings to prevent large sparks from becoming a fire hazard.

Property owners will be invoiced for the full cost of the call out should the fire department respond to complaints about backyard burning that is contrary to the above regulations. A source of water should be close at hand in the event it becomes necessary to put out the fire.
